

## NICLA BOLUS

### **Composition:**

Each bolus contains:

Niclosamide 3.75 g

### **Description :**

Niclosamide affects the parasite's cell by locking the Crip ring in the tape worms leading to accumulating of Lactic acid and then the death of the Parasite .

### **Indications:**

Gastrointestinal nematodes: larval and adult stages of Haemonchus, Ostertagia, Trichostrongylus, Nematodirus, Cooperia Bunostomum; adult stages of Oesophagostomum, Chabertia and Strongyloides.

Tapeworms: Moniezia.

Liverfluke: Fasciola hepatica

In cattle, sheep and goats

### **Contraindications :**

Not to be used at early pregnancy

### **Usage:**

The bolus is posited at the tongue base, then water is poured with lifting the head upwards.

### **Dosage :**

Cattle : 1 bolus per 100 kg body weight .

Sheep and goats : half bolus per animal .

### **Withdrawal time:**

Meat : 14 days      Milk : 5 days

### **Storage:**

Store in airtight containers, in a moderate temperature (15-25 C) and protect form direct sunlight.

### **Packing:**

Pack of 50 boluses.
